Re: Montana Land Information Act (MLIA) Grant Funding Approved Recommendations

Please find the attached report on State Fiscal Year 2019 Montana Land Information Act grant funding recommendations based on MAR 10.102.9105.

The Montana Land Information Advisory Council (MLIAC) approved the total grant funding for the FY2019 Montana Land Information Plan at \$250,000. There was a total of 24 grant applications considered for funding. The MLIAC Grant Subcommittee reviewed and scored all applications. The Subcommittee recommended to the Council that 14 applications be considered for funding.

The Council approved the following recommendations at their April 19, 2018 meeting in Helena.

1. Approve the prioritized list, included in the report below for funding for grants 1-12, a total of \$232,963.
2. Approve the following method for the remaining grant funds, a total of \$17,037:
 - a. Offer the remaining funds to the City of Harlem for funding portions of their grant.
 - i. If the City of Harlem accepts the funding, the Bitterroot Conservation District would not receive funding.
 1. The State GIS Coordinator will work the City to develop a statement of work to include stipulations and recommendations.
 - ii. If the City of Harlem refuses the funding, fully funding the Bitterroot Conservation District at \$14,000. The remaining balance (\$2,637) would stay in the MLIAC account for future MLIA use.
