Re:	Setting Meeting Dates for 2019 & Other Important Dates		

Traditionally, the Montana Land Information Advisory Council meets four times a year, on Thursdays, in April, June, September, and November.

The April Meeting is usually held in conjunction with the Montana Association of Geographic Information Professionals annual GIS Conference. This year the conference will be held from April 1 - 5. The main priority of the April Council meeting is to approve Grant Project Funding. This meeting occurs earlier than normal, in the first week of the month.

The September Council meeting the draft Land Information Plan is typically approved to be published for public comment.

At the November the council must finalize and approve the next fiscal year's Land Information Plan.
