In compliance with ARM 10.102.9104, the Montana State Library is seeking public input on the goals and priorities of next year's Land Information Plan from October 22, 2019, to November 4, 2019. All public comment will be considered a public record and will be reviewed and considered in the final version of the Land Information Plan.
