Montana's Ground-Water Monitoring Network - Map 12

Map 12 shows the monitoring well network as of December 1996. Wells are selected to represent the principal surficial and bedrock aquifers that are widely used for water supply. There are approximately 550 wells shown on the map. The water level from each well on the map is measured quarterly. About ten percent of the wells have continuous water-level recorders installed on them. Information collected by the program is entered into a data base and is available from the MBMG Ground-Water Information Center (GWIC) in Butte, Montana.
