

VERIZON JETPACK USER GUIDE

FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR VERIZON JETPACK.

1. Press the **Power button** to turn on the Verizon Jetpack. If the Jetpack does not power on, it may be necessary to charge the device.



2. Establish a Wi-Fi network connection between the Jetpack and a device:
 - a. The Wi-Fi name and password are obtained via the external LED of the Jetpack.
 - b. To connect your device, follow the instructions below for the correct operating system:




iOS / Apple OS INSTRUCTIONS

1. From the menu bar, click the Wi-Fi icon (located in the top-right)



2. Click the preferred network.
3. If presented, enter the Wi-Fi network password, then click **Join**.
4. **System Preferences:**
 - a. From the Macintosh desktop, navigate to Apple > System Preferences.
 - b. Click Network.
 - c. Ensure AirPort/Wi-Fi is the selected network service. (AirPort/Wi-Fi is unavailable unless a module is installed.)
 - d. From the **Network Name** dropdown menu, click the preferred network.
 - e. If presented, enter the network password then click OK.

WINDOWS OS INSTRUCTIONS

1. From the Windows desktop, tap or click the **Wi-Fi icon**  (located in the lower-right, in the task bar).
 - a. Alternate navigation: click **Windows icon**  (lower-left) > **Settings icon**  > **Network & Internet** > **Show available networks**.
2. From the Wi-Fi section select an available network.
3. Click **Connect**.
4. If prompted, enter the appropriate network security key or username and password then click **OK**.
