



Visit your library's website and click on the catalog search link or go to <http://mtsc.sdp.sirsi.net> and select your library from the "Find your local library's catalog" drop down menu.

Access and Review Your Library Account

- In the upper right corner of the library catalog, click on "Log In" and enter your card number (with no spaces) and PIN; then click "Log In."
- If you have changed your pin and no longer remember it, use the "Forgot my PIN" link to reset the PIN.
- Once you have logged in, click on "My Account" in the upper right corner.
- From here, you can review your account, renew your items, change your PIN, manage your holds, and review fines.

Search Strategies

- Use the drop down menu to search other Montana Shared Catalog libraries, additional library catalogs such as the Library of Congress, or select “Discover It” to search all library resources at once including books, databases, and the Montana Memory Project.
- Select “All Fields” to do a keyword search, or use the drop down menu to limit by author, title, subject, or series.
- After your search results are displayed, use the links and check-boxes along the left hand side of the screen—called facets—to limit your search by author, format, subject, publication date, and more. Click on a title link to view detailed item information and availability for that title.
- For additional assistance with searching or other catalog options, click on the  icon in the top-right corner of the page or contact your local library.

Log Out

Make sure to select “Log Out” in the upper right corner of the library catalog when you finish, especially if you’re using a public computer.



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
