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Important Dates

Enrollment Period: 11/1/18 - 12/15/18

Medicare Enrollment Period: 10/15/18 - 12/15/18

These are the time periods where people can make changes to their existing health insurance plans or enroll in a new plan for 2019. All plans/changes that are made during these time periods will take effect starting January 1st, 2019

Ideas for Programming

1. Host a local SHIP counselor at your library to give health insurance advice for Medicare
 - a. SHIP = State Health and Insurance Assistance Program
 - b. The Montana State Health Insurance Assistance Program (**SHIP**) is a free health-benefits counseling and advocacy service for Medicare beneficiaries and their families or caregivers. Our mission is to educate, advocate FOR, counsel and empower people to make informed benefit decisions.
