

This report contains statistical information for Red Lodge Carnegie Library. All statistics are for the reporting period July 2014 through June 2015. The library cooperates with the Montana State Library and in turn the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS), which develops and compiles national public library statistics for the United States. Red Lodge Carnegie Library provides this information so that policy-makers, funders, trustees, and librarians can identify trends in the country's library services.

The information in the report is presented in two main sections - general data elements and performance measures. In the first section, data elements are listed with their rankings within the state. These rankings are based on the 82 total public libraries in the state of Montana, a rank of one represents the highest value and ties have been resolved alphabetically.

The items in the second section, performance measures, are included because of their potential applications to library services planning and because of their usefulness as general indicators of library service.
