GEOGRAPHIC & NATURAL RESOURCE INFORMATION

CADASTRAL



Identify owners of land parcels and explore the state's property assessment database.

PLACE NAMES



Explore the history of Montana cities, towns, and geographic features.

DIGITAL ATLAS



Find geographic locations in Montana and explore geographic databases, aerial photos, and topographic maps.

MONTANA FIELD GUIDES



Learn about the identification, habitat, ecology, reproduction, range, and distribution of Montana's plants and animals.

CADASTRAL

Cadastral data is the information about rights and interest in land.

Cadastral data may also be known as real

estate data, parcel information, or tax parcel information.






